




PAY ATTENTION TO HOW A CAR LOOKS, FEELS, SOUNDS AND SMELLS - IT'S IMPORTANT!

Test driving tips

Use this checklist for tips on what to do and look for when you test drive a car.

Remember, the surest way to pinpoint any mechanical issues is to get a professional pre-purchase vehicle inspection after you have taken it for a spin.



Ask the seller not to turn on or run the car at least a few hours beforehand.



Plan your test drive route.

Bring a friend if you don't know much about cars.



Go during the day in fair weather.

Do basic checks before you drive it.



Make sure the car is legally allowed on the road. Ask if it's insured.



Test on roads you will drive on most often.



Put safety first.



Pay attention to how it looks, feels, sounds and smells — is anything odd?



If the test drive goes well, get a professional pre-purchase inspection to ID any hidden problems.
